## Message from the treasurer

FONDATION CHARLES-BRUNEAU

**As part of the presentation of its financial results for the 2020-2021 financial year, the Fondation Charles-Bruneau is pleased to announce that it has recorded net earnings of \$5,132,489. In spite of difficult circumstances, the Fondation remitted sums totalling \$3,097,695 to the four hospitals it supports so as to ensure that no research projects in progress were delayed or abandoned.**

Nor surprisingly, the cancellation of some fundraising events resulted in slower growth in the Fondation's revenues. But thanks to our joint efforts, the Fondation was able to honour all its commitments. In the face of difficult circumstances, we remitted sums totalling \$3,097,695 to the four hospitals supported so as to ensure that no research projects in progress were delayed or abandoned.

Meanwhile, administrative costs were subject to rigorous management, accounting for only 18.26% of recorded revenues.

Again this year, we owe an immense debt of gratitude to our donors, partners, the participants in our events, and our volunteers. The positive results presented here attest to your generosity and the trust you have placed in us.

We can be proud as we continue to advance together towards a cancer-free childhood.

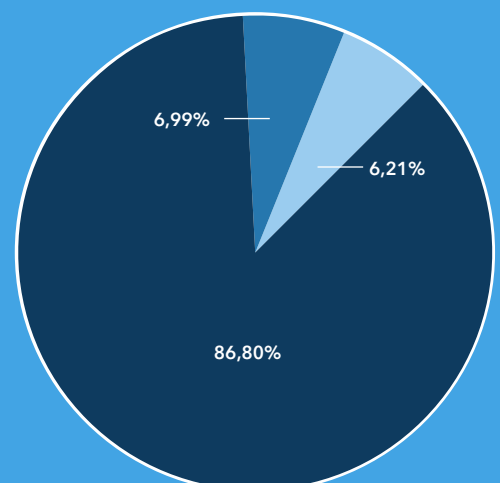
