## Message from the treasurer

FONDATION CHARLES-BRUNEAU

As part of the presentation of its financial results for the 2021-2022 financial year, the Fondation Charles-Bruneau announces net earnings of \$ 5 572 100. Following the historic commitment announced last June, the Fondation remitted a record sum to the four Quebec hospitals it supports in an effort to stimulate the development of projects aimed at fighting pediatric cancer. Since the announcement was made a year ago, the Fondation has distributed total of \$8,777,459 between the CHU Sainte-Justine, the CHU de Québec - Université Laval, the Montreal Children's Hospital, and the CHU de Sherbrooke. In comparison, the sums remitted to these hospitals during the previous year totalled \$3,097,696.

Administrative expenses were managed in a highly rigorous manner, accounting for only 17% of revenues recorded, compared to 18.26% the previous year.

Whether you are a donor, a partner, a volunteer or a participant in our events, we owe you an enormous debt of gratitude. The unprecedented results we have posted here are a testament to your generosity and the trust you have placed in the Fondation.

**Let's continue working together towards a cancer-free childhood!**

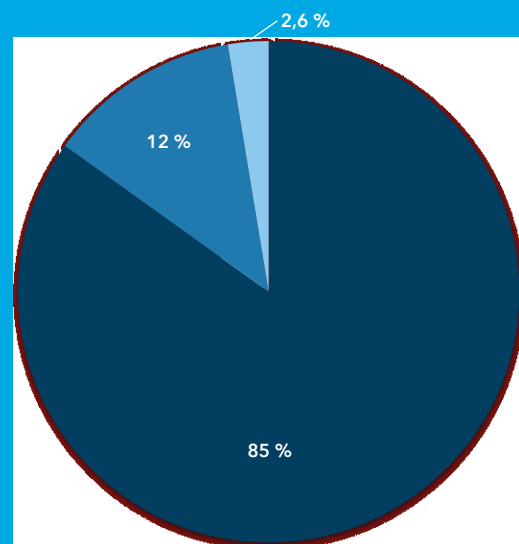

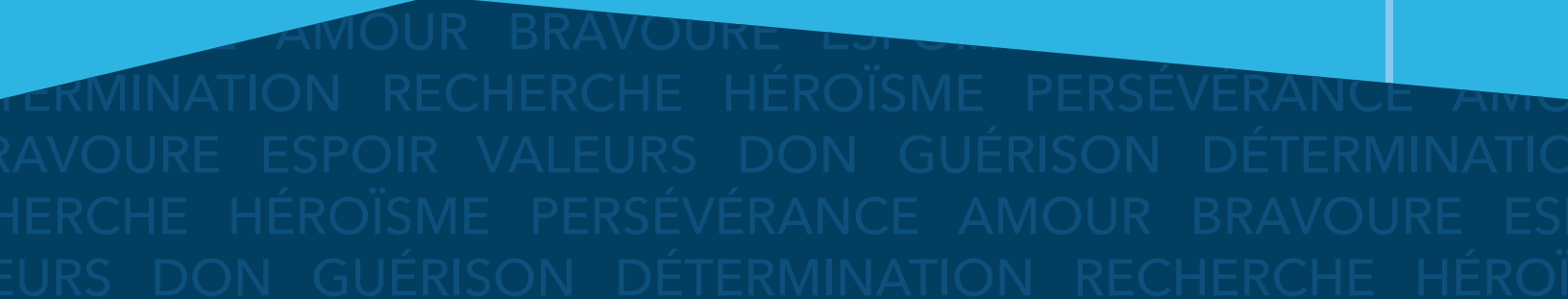
